

COTS' Integrity Housing program provides shared housing to homeless individuals and families who are looking for permanent housing in this challenging housing market. Our partner landlords master lease multi-bedroom units to COTS, and we sublease individual rooms to our clients. COTS shares maintenance responsibilities with property owners at these units. Hundreds of people have been housing through this program, and we need your help in continuing its success!

How can you help? COTS is looking for small groups to help maintain the outdoor spaces at seven of our Integrity Housing units. The type and amount of work varies at each home, and COTS can match your group with the perfect home for your groups' skillset and availability. Volunteers must be 18 years or older to participate.

What does it take to Adopt-A-Home?

We are looking for groups that can commit to:

- Adopting an Integrity Housing unit for a minimum of one year
- Assist with yard maintenance quarterly at your adopted home
- Align with COTS' commitment to environmental justice by using only electric powered machinery

What your group will receive:

- Listing on our website as an Adopt-A-Home Partner
- Social media acknowledgement
- Listing in our annual report as an Adopt-A-Home Partner
- Staff liaisons to assist on clean up days
